



LIFT Summer Programming 2024

Permission forms will now run through our new platform, AfterschoolHQ.

If you have ever completed a LIFT permission form for your student, then we have already imported everything into this platform, so all you need to do is click the below link and follow the prompts to get your account live. You do not need to complete the form in its entirety.

If you have completed a LIFT permission form for your student in the past & have had your information imported into this new system by LIFT staff:

Follow the link below > Click Register > You'll be met with a "Welcome Back" message > From here you can reset your password (*that was created for you during the info import*) & register for "LIFT Summer Programming 2024" > Complete the registration form > Submit registration form > **DONE**

On the registration form, the only sections you **MUST** complete are:

- Student name
- Your name
- Full "agreeances" section
- **ENSURE** you check the box that says, "I have filled out a LIFT permission form for my student previously, and no key information has changed since then. Please refer to those responses for all student information"

If this is your first LIFT permission form:

Follow the link below > Click Register > Enter your email address > Enter name, email, & a password - add a phone number to receive text notifications if you'd like > Complete the registration form > Submit registration form > **DONE**

On the registration form, please fill out the full form even if questions say optional. The only questions you do **NOT** need to answer are:

- Question: Student T-shirt size
- Question: Ethnicity
- Section: Additional Parent/Guardian Information
- Section: Additional Parent/Guardian Address
- Section: Emergency Contact #2



If you complete the form for your student, and we find that information is missing, know that we will reach out to ensure we have everything on file as summer gets under way. Thank you!

Transportation will again be offered on a free, limited basis to any student living within 9 miles of Glen Lake Community, Northport Public or Suttons Bay Public Schools.

- Every 2 - 3 weeks, Mrs. Murphy and Miss Coda will email you the schedule of events for the upcoming 2 - 3 weeks with transportation request links for each activity.
 - If you reside within the above 9-mile radius, and if your student is interested in attending a given activity, you will fill out the transportation request form for the preferred day(s) just like you would for a normal RSVP day.
- If you do not reside 9 miles or fewer from one of the schools in which we operate, your student is still welcome to join programming as long as they have a ride to and from the activity.
- You must complete these transportation forms no less than 24 hours in advance of any days you're requesting transportation for.
- To be respectful of everyone's time (*our students', our partners' and our own*) if we arrive at your home for pick-up and your student is not ready within 5 minutes (barring any emergency), they will forfeit their space for the day.

Regarding **activities and scheduling**, programming will be offered consistently three days a week during summer, excluding any week(s) where there is a special event scheduled.

- Please expect your student to be picked up and dropped off 30 - 60 minutes before and after the programming time listed on the calendar pending on where your home lies on the pick-up / drop-off route for that day.
- Currently, the calendar on our website does show our plans for the summer ahead but is subject to change as need-be.
 - Any scheduling changes will be communicated as soon as they are known to help you plan best.



- LIFT activities hosted during summer are open to any incoming 6th - 12th grader in Leelanau County.
 - If you have - or know - Leelanau County students in the 9th - 12th grade range, they are welcome to participate in any programming offered by LIFT this summer.
 - If they'd like to join for programming activities listed on the main calendar found on the website, they may, but priority will be given to incoming 6th - 8th graders.
 - Incoming 6th - 8th graders may join us for activities only on the 6th - 12th grade calendar.
